An easy to use plan for a Children's Meeting on Advice & Query 23

Make sure that you have a little time of worship for yourself and other volunteers before the session – even a couple of minutes are good.

This outline is based on there being 45 minutes or so for your children's meeting. Ask children or parents at a previous session about bringing wedding photos. If necessary have copies of photos from *Additional Resources 47.A*. Set the room out as suggested in Gather on page 1 of the of *Journeys in the Spirit* children's edition issue 47.

Gather After the group has settled, however many or few, ask everybody to say their names. Then do the centering exercise on page 1 of the of *Journeys in the Spirit* children's edition issue 47 using the bowl and pebbles. ⌚ 5 mins

Engage Do the 'who lives in my house' activity on page 2 of the of *Journeys in the Spirit* children's edition issue 47. ⌚ 15 mins

Respond Do the 'who lives in my house' activity on page 3 of the of *Journeys in the Spirit* children's edition issue 7. ⌚ 15mins

Reflect Finish with the reflection activities as outlined on page 4 of *Journeys in the Spirit* children's edition issue 47, leaving out the part that refers to acting out a Quaker wedding. ⌚ 10 mins
