This activity invites the group to engage with the different Quaker flavours through a quiz. If there are people in the group with mobility issues this could be modified into a sitting down quiz.

Label the four walls of the room with the four main types of Quakerism – EFI, FUM, FGC, Conservative and in the centre, independent. Then ask the following, asking people to answer by taking themselves to the correct area in the room. There may be more than one answer, be open to debate.
