The rest of the pupils on the council think it is a brilliant idea, however you are uneasy about receiving money from Shell. How do you respond?

- 3) You have spent the weekend at a Quaker event for young people and you're back at school the following day. At break, you and your friends are talking about what everyone has done at the weekend and you mention that you were on a Quaker youth weekend. One of your friends asks 'What's a Quaker?' How do you respond?

- 4) You have a play station and you and your mates have been playing games together over the internet link up. They want you to play 'Call of duty' but you don't have that game as your Quaker parents don't want you to be playing war games. Your friend offers to lend it to you. How do you respond?

- 5) You are in a Religious Studies lesson and the teacher is talking about Quakers. They are getting lots of the information wrong and it is beginning to annoy you. Not many people at school know you're from a Quaker family and you're worried about what they might think if they know but you also don't think that your class should be given miss information. How do you respond?
