## Making a film

There are different ways of designing a film. Your choice will depend on how much time you have, and whether you can edit your film, as well as the sort of film you want to make.

You could...

- interview someone, to see what they have to say about being a Quaker.
- write a script, and read it out (or ask friends to).
- write a play, and act it.

Plan a 'storyboard' - write down the pictures and words you want to include in your film, before filming the different sections.

Most films are made by a whole team of people. If your group is making a film, decide who will do the different jobs. The camera person does the actual filming. One or more writers create the script. Some films have a narrator, to read the words, or a presenter, talking to the camera. You might have an interviewer and people being interviewed. If you're making a drama, you will need actors.
