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A simple plan for an all age Meeting for Worship

If possible, hold an all-age meeting for worship when the children have had the time and opportunity to engage with the theme, so that they will be able to contribute as fully as possible to the Meeting. Make sure that everyone has access to paper, pens and craft materials without disrupting the worship.

- Gather in stillness, with perhaps some soft music.
- Towards the beginning of the meeting, have either *Advices and Queries* 37 & 38 – or the children’s versions of these (see Respond) read out. Include children in this if possible.
- Next, one or all of the stories about John Woolman, William Penn and Elisabeth Abegg should be read out / presented by the children – with suitable periods of stillness between them, so that people can reflect.
- Next explain that we are all going to work together to create a Meeting Poster representing our responses to these *Advices and stories*. People can respond in words or pictures, or by creating a collage. Encourage people to work quietly in groups and to help one another.
- Finish with another period of stillness, during which people wonder at and reflect at what has been produced.
