Topical activity Meeting for worship for all ages



This is the large meeting house in Friends House in London. At Yearly Meeting this year a Meeting for Worship for all ages was held in the large meeting house.

A story was read about *God's quiet things*; some questions were asked about what quiet things people had noticed during Yearly Meeting and what quiet things they liked. Then people could draw quiet things on their hands using their finger whilst waiting in the quiet for any ministry from themselves or other Friends.
