



# Action Points

## Questions which might be asked by visitors

This gives you some ideas of questions visitors might ask. They might ask specific questions if they already know you're involved in a specific way such as peace campaigning.

### Experience of Quakerism

- What first drew you to Quaker Meeting?
- Why do you want to become a member?
- What has your experience been of Meeting for Worship? Of ministry? Of silence?
- Have you attended Meetings for Worship other than at the meeting you usually go to?
- What other Quaker activities have you been involved in? What has been your experience (positive or negative) of these?
- What point do you feel you have reached on your own spiritual journey and what ups and downs have you experienced on the way?
- What are your beliefs, or difficulties, about God or the Spirit?
- Are you aware of the diversity of Quakers in Britain and the world-wide Quaker family?
- What is your understanding of the Quaker testimonies in general and the Peace testimony in particular?

### Responsibilities of membership

- Have you attended a Quaker business meeting?
- What is your understanding of the Quaker decision making process?
- Do you have ideas about what you could contribute to the meeting? Is there a Quaker role you would like to do?

There are no right or wrong answers to these questions; no creeds that have to be accepted and no tests of attitudes or lifestyle will be carried out.
